


Installation

After the installation, you'll find the module shortcut in the extended paramters



Click "add new" to create a new entry





Publish

You can publish/unpublish your content block

TinyMCE

Activate oder deactivate the TinyMCE editor

Content

Create your own content with the familar TinyMCE editor. You also can switch languages as you know it from other sections in PrestaShop.

Class

Apply an own CSS class to your block. If you are familiar with CSS, you can easily style it later. Or if you are familiar with bootstrap, you can use implemented bootstrap classes as e.g. col-lg-6 to achive a responsible half-width column. Refer to the bootstrap manual to learn about other CSS classes used in the restashop theme.

Copy language

After adding a content, you can clone it to other languages just to not let them be empty. It is usefull if you use a standard picture, or an embedded googlemap, that should be copied to other store's languages manually. This button saves time and prevents you from forgetting it. Remember to save changes afterwards.


Move

You can move the content inside a hook position. Normally, all the contentique records within one hook are stored under each other. If you want to mix them up with other modules within the hook you can use the move option. Just try it out.

You also can use Backoffice hooks to write your own notes or, include some important content.


Hook into

Open the list. Hook at one or more positions in which your content should appear. There are various sides and positions.



Exceptions Management

If your content uses a hook that is present on every shop's page, you might want to have some exceptions. For instance, if you use the left side for a contact info, you might want to hide it on a contact page itself. Therefore, there are exceptions. You can hide content exceptionally or you can show content exceptionally:



You can switch between pages, categories, products, manufacturers and CMS pages to create your own exceptions and inceptions for each content block!
